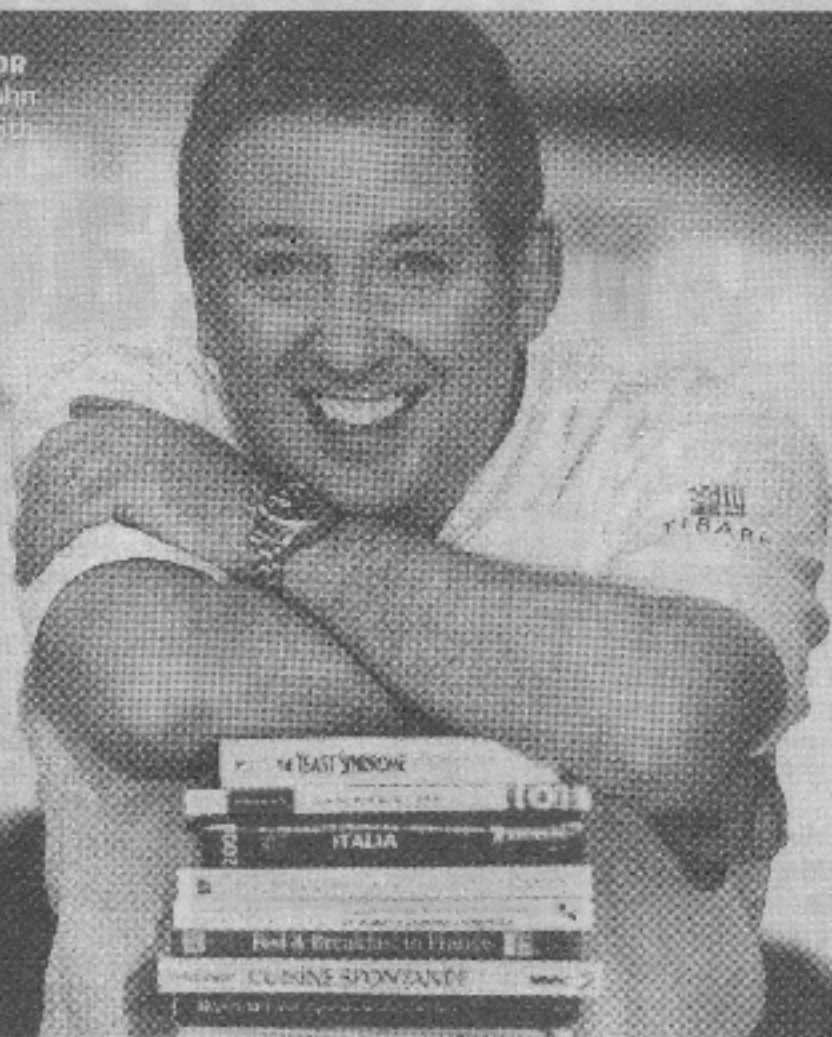


COOKING WITH THE BOOKS OF AN EXPERT
